TRAVEL BAN EXEMPTION REQUESTS

Pursuant to the IATF Resolution No. 110 dated 15 April 2021, amending IATF Resolution No. 103 dated 18 March 2021, the temporary suspension of entry of Foreign Nationals to the Philippines has been **extended to 30 April 2021**.

However, without prejudice to immigration rules and quarantine protocols and the existence of a valid visa at the time of entry, Foreign Nationals may be allowed entry to the Philippines provided they have:

- (1) valid exemption documents duly issued by the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) <u>prior</u> to 22 March 2021; or
- (2) valid exemption documents approved and issued by the NTF Chairperson/his duly authorized representative <u>due to emergency, humanitarian and analogous cases</u>, in accordance with NTF Memo Circular No. 5 series of 2021.

The PEZA-Foreign National Unit (PEZA-FNU) will temporarily defer accepting/processing requests for PEZA Endorsements for Travel Ban Exemptions to the DFA-OCA until 30 April 2021. We enjoin all PEZA locators to file/refile their requests after 30 April 2021, or until further notice.
