3. What is the technical specifications of the steel poles, Manual Transfer Switch (MTS) and LVSG?	Kindly refer to Annex "C"
4. As per technical specifications of the Gensets, the minimum Manufacturer's warranty is for two (2) years. Please clarify, because the usual warranty is for One (1) year only. Do we need to submit Warranty Certificate?	Warranty Certificate covering the two (2) year period is to be attached as part of the Technical Documents.
5. Do you have a required elevation for site grading?	No site grading is required based on site inspection
6. Kindly provide Soil investigation report for the design of genset pad.- How far is the tapping source from project site? (Water & electricity).	No site investigation is required. Tapping sources are conveniently available upon application with BCEZ.
