SUPPLEMENTAL/BID BULLETIN NO. 01 (September 26, 2014)

This Bulletin is issued to clarify the Bid Documents and shall form an integral part of the Bid Documents.

The following are the official answers of the BAC on the queries of Keylargo Industrial Sales and Promark Process Int'l Corp. during the Pre – Bid Conference last 23 September 2014:

Question 1: Is PEZA-BCEZ open for alternative method of operation for its STP?

Answer: No. PEZA-BCEZ has no plan to consider alternative method of operating the STP as of this date. Engr. M. De Vera mentioned that the BCEZ -STP was designed for "Tsurumi" Submersible Aerators installed since the BCEZ-STP was operated in 2005 to the present, the control panel, mounting, etc. have never been altered to consider other type of aerator.

Question 2: This project is only for supply and delivery?

Answer: Yes, installation will be done by PEZA-BCEZ through its service contractor – ERA Integrated Corp.

Question 3: Will the procuring entity consider other brand of the same quality?

Answer: No, but bidders may submit their product specification for future reference.

Question 4: How about if other brand of the same quality offered do not affect the set-up?



Question5: Completed/on-going projects related to deep well submersible pumps can be included in the "Statement of all Government & Private Contracts completed which are similar in nature - Annex B"?

Answer: Yes, according to Engr. M. De Vera, all similar or related projects involving deep well submersible pumps may be included.
