# Contract for the Procurement of Maintenance Agreement for CISCO Wireless Network Equipment Deployed at the Head Office and Public Economic Zones: CEZ, MEZ & BCEZ

THIS AGREEMENT made on the \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_ 2019 between PHILIPPINE ECONOMIC ZONE AUTHORITY (hereinafter called "the Entity") of the one part and TRENDS & TECHNOLOGIES, INC. (hereinafter called "the Supplier") of the other part:

WHEREAS the Entity invited Bids for certain goods and ancillary services, viz., Procurement of Maintenance Agreement for CISCO Wireless Network Equipment Deployed at the Head Office and Public Economic Zones: CEZ, MEZ & BCEZ and has accepted the Bid of the Supplier for the supply of those goods in the sum of PESOS: Two Million Two Hundred Eighty Thousand Only (\$\perp\$2,280,000.00) (hereinafter called "the Contract Price").

### NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract.
- 2. The following documents shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as part of this Agreement, viz.:
  - (a) the Bid Form and the Price Schedule submitted by the Bidder;
  - (b) the Schedule of Requirements;
  - (c) the Technical Specifications;
  - (d) the General Conditions of Contract;
  - (e) the Special Conditions of Contract;
  - (f) the Performance Security; and
  - (g) the Entity's Notice of Award.
- 3. In consideration of the payments to be made by the Entity to the Supplier as hereinafter mentioned, the Supplier hereby commits to provide the goods and services and to remedy defects therein in conformity in all respects with the provisions of the Conditions of Contract.
- 4. The Entity hereby commits to pay the Supplier in consideration of the provision of the goods and services and the remedying of defects therein, the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable under the provisions of the Conditions of Contract at the time and in the manner prescribed by the Contract.
- 5. In relation to this Contract, the Supplier shall pay taxes in full and on time and that failure to do so will entitle the Entity to suspend payment on the goods and services delivered by the Supplier.
- 6. The Supplier shall also present to the Entity a tax clearance from the Bureau of Internal Revenue as well as a copy of its income and business tax returns duly stamped and received by the BIR and duly validated with the tax payments made thereon.

# 5. CUSTOMER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

For TRENDS to provide support excellence, CUSTOMER should:

- 5.1. Nominate at least one (1) appropriate person to be CUSTOMER's contact with TRENDS regarding Maintenance Services (such person to be regularly available during normal business hours).
- 5.2. Ensure that TRENDS maintenance personnel have free, safe and uninterrupted access to the Equipment at all times during the provision of the Services.
- 5.3. Make available on request the services of any person who operates the Equipment at the Site. In such case, TRENDS shall give reasonable notice to CUSTOMER as to the necessity of the presence of such person during the provision of Services.
- 5.4. Notify TRENDS immediately in writing if CUSTOMER ceases to be in possession of the Equipment at the Site.
- 5.5. Assume responsibilities for Equipment failure caused by:
  - a. Relocation or movement of the Equipment without TRENDS' assistance.
  - b. Neglect or misuse by CUSTOMER or incidents including power failure or any failure not attributable to the Equipment.
  - c. Changes on the Equipment including but not limited to addition or removal of modules, power supplies or accessories without TRENDS' support.
- 5.6. Provide the appropriate training(s) / briefing(s) / protocol(s) required to access or perform the service within the Site(s).

# 6. SPARE PARTS MANAGEMENT SERVICES ("SPMS")

Based on operational experience, it is anticipated that from time to time spare parts will be required to support service and maintenance operations.

TRENDS can undertake to hold critical spares, which can be mobilized at short notice to the operational site. These spares are stored at our offices in Makati, Cavite, Cebu and Davao. This service guarantees agreed availability as the needed parts can be dispatched when need for shipment to site arise
