INVITATION TO BID FOR SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF MANPOWER, TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT FOR THE CLEAN & GREEN AND FACILITIES MAINTENANCE OF MACTAN ECONOMIC ZONE CONTRACT NO. PEZA MEZ 2019-003

1. The **Philippine Economic Zone Authority**, through the Corporate Budget for the year 2019 intends to apply the sum of **Nine Million Fifty Six Thousand Two Hundred Sixty Four Pesos and 45/100 (Php 9,056,264.45)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for **Supply and Delivery of Manpower, Tools and Equipment for the Clean & Green and Facilities Maintenance of Mactan Economic Zone**. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The **Philippine Economic Zone Authority** now invites bids for **Supply and Delivery of Manpower, Tools and Equipment for the Clean & Green and Facilities Maintenance of Mactan Economic Zone**.¹ Delivery of the Goods is required within ten (10) days from receipt of Notice to Proceed, and is required for a duration of one year only which may be extended/ renewed to a maximum of two (2) years. Bidders should have completed, within three (3) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183.

4. Interested bidders may obtain further information from **Philippine Economic Zone Authority** and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from **8:00 AM to 5:00 PM; Monday to Friday**.
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on **August 8, 2019** from the address, 2/F PEZA Administration Building, Mactan Economic Zone, Lapu-lapu City, Cebu and upon payment of the non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of **Php 10,000.00**.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that Bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

6. The **Philippine Economic Zone Authority** will hold a Pre-Bid Conference² on **August 16, 2019 at 2:00 PM** at 2/F PEZA Administration Building, Mactan Economic Zone, Lapu-lapu City, Cebu, which shall be open to prospective bidders.

7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat at the address below on or before **August 28, 2019**. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB Clause Error! Reference source not found.**

Bid opening shall be on **August 28, 2019 at 2:00 PM** at 2/F PEZA Administration Building, Mactan Economic Zone, Lapu-lapu City, Cebu. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.

8. The **Philippine Economic Zone Authority** reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
