



## RESOLUTION NO. 2019-06FB

**WHEREAS**, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) posted an Invitation to Bid (ITB) for the **Security Services Requirement of PEZA (PEZA-HO-2019-06)** in the amount of PhP26,705,574.00 (ABC) through a competitive bidding pursuant to RA 9184.

**WHEREAS**, the ITB for the said Security Services Requirement of PEZA was posted in the PEZA website, PhilGeps and conspicuous place at the PEZA premises continuously for seven (7) days, indicating therein 06 May 2019 (11:00AM) as the deadline of submission of bids; The following bidders submitted their proposals:

1. 3i International Security Services, Inc.;
2. Jantro Security Agency, Inc.; and
3. EliteBlue Security Specialist Inc.

For lack of quorum, the opening of bids scheduled on the same date at 2:00PM was moved to the next day, with the bidders having been properly notified of the rescheduled date verbally at a meeting and through supplemental bid bulletin No. 2019-07.

**WHEREAS**, on 07 May 2017 (date of opening of bids), the bid proposals were read as follows:

And having passed the requirements for the Eligibility, Technical and Financial Proposals, the aforesaid bids were accepted for detailed evaluation and post-qualification

**WHEREAS**, upon detailed Bid Evaluation to determine the Lowest Calculated Responsive Bid (LCRB), the TWG, as indicated in its Evaluation Report to BAC dated May 14 and further explained in its Memorandum dated May 21, found all bid proposals Non-Responsive based on the following:

- EliteBlue Security Specialist, Inc. – In reference to “Annex E” form required, its bid proposal for Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR) rate is below the minimum Philippine Association of Detective and Protective Agency Operators (PADPAO) rates which is P320 – Daily Wage. In the Annex E form submitted the rate indicated is 315-Daily Wage, thus Non-Responsive;
- Jantro Security Agency, Inc. – In relation to ITB 15.2, i.e., “xxx Bids not addressing or providing all of the required items in the Bidding Documents. Including, where applicable, Schedule of Prices, shall be considered non-responsive and thus, automatically disqualified. In this regard, where a required item is provided, but no price is indicated, the same shall be considered as non-responsive, but specifying a zero (0) or a dash (-) for the said item would mean that it is being offered for free to the Government, except those required by law or regulations to be accomplished.”

The “Annex E” form submitted did not indicate the price on the Overtime Pay Item, nor a zero (0), nor a dash (-). Also, it did not submit the required signed form of Annex F thereby making their submitted bid incomplete, thus non-responsive; and

- 3i International Security Services – the submitted “Annex E” form is not the form required, specifically it added another column and provided for a threshold in number of employees against which a certain rate would be applicable, thus likewise non-responsive.

The Bid Documents provide, as additional requirements, in Section III. Bid Data Sheet (ITB Clause 13.1 (a) and b) that “*in the evaluation of the bids, the BAC shall strictly enforce the PADPAO rates for Amounts Due to the Guards and Amounts Due to the Government (as Annex E), and the submission of Add-Ons, if any (as Annex F)*”, respectively;

Hence, we hereby declare failure of bidding under Section 35 of RA 9184, specifically 35.1 (c);

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in view of the above premises, We, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED, to recommend the conduct of re-bidding within 15 days immediately after review and evaluation of the terms, conditions and specification in the ITB, including its cost estimates.
