In connection with the project, **Solid Waste Management Services at Mactan Economic Zone [Collection, Transport and Disposal of MEZ Non-Hazardous Solid Waste]**, please be informed of the Addendum to the Terms and Conditions dated 5 August 2019;

C. ADDENDUM TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

17.0 The service provider must ensure a daily service efficiency of 80% (as per daily schedule basis). Failure to do so, the service provider must pay PEZA liquidated damages, not by way of penalty, a fix amount of Php10,000 for every day of delay. In case the sum of liquidated damages reaches 10% of the contract amount, PEZA may rescind or terminate the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it. PEZA may also take over the contract or award the same to a qualified service provider through negotiation. In addition to the liquidated damages, the erring service provider's security shall also be forfeited.

18.0 If delays are likely to be incurred, the service provider must notify PEZA in writing. It must state therein the cause/s, duration of the expected delay, and action plan to ensure service continuity. PEZA may grant time extensions, at its discretion, if based on meritorious grounds, with or without liquidated damages.
