BAC RESOLUTION NO. 2023-07

WHEREAS, the Philippine Economic Zone Authority (PEZA) through its Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) conducted a public bidding for the “Procurement of Security Services Requirement of PEZA” (PEZA-HO-2023-01) with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of One Hundred Fifty-Five Million, Six Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-Three Pesos in Philippine Currency (PhP155,623,353.00);

WHEREAS, on 20 February 2023, the deadline for Submission and Opening of Bids, two (2) bidders submitted bids, Advanced Remote Managed Security Services Inc. (ARMSSI) and Jantro Security Agency Inc. (JSAI);

WHEREAS, during the post-qualifications, the BAC with the assistance of its TWG examined and verified the bidders submitted bids/documents and found that none of the bidders are qualified, to wit: a) ARMSSI failed to comply with the required minimum agency fee of 20% of the total contract cost; b) JSAI failed to submit the required favorable recommendation from one of its three (3) largest clients/contracts, the Lagoon Development Corp;

WHEREAS, on 28 February 2023, BAC issued Resolution No. 2023-05, declaring a failure of bidding on the ground provided under paragraph c, Section 35 of the Republic Act (RA) No. 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), all bids failed post-qualifications;

WHEREAS, on 07 March 2023, the BAC informed bidders of failure to post-qualify through BAC Resolution No. 2023-05 dated 28 February 2023;

WHEREAS, on 10 March 2023, ARMSSI and JSAI submitted their respective Motion for Reconsideration (MR) on BAC Resolution No. 2023-05;

WHEREAS, on 15 March 2023, the BAC with the assistance of its TWG deliberated on the merits of the Bidders MRs;

WHEREAS, on 20 March 2023, BAC issued Resolution No. 2023-06 dated 17 March 2023, declaring that:

1. The Motion for Reconsideration of ARMSSI is denied without prejudice to its right under Section 55 of RA No. 9184. All concerned parties shall be forthwith informed with the resolution;
2. The Motion for Reconsideration of JSAI is granted and All concerned parties shall be forthwith informed with the resolution; and
3. The BAC with the assistance of its TWG will proceed with the mandatory random ocular inspection and/or site visit of JSAI;

WHEREAS, on 21 March 2023, notified JSAI to submit post-qualification documents within five (5) calendar days from receipt thereof;

WHEREAS, on 24 March 2023, BAC with the assistance of TWG in accordance with its issued Resolution No. 2023-06 dated 17 March 2023 conducted the ocular inspection of JSAI at Biñan, Laguna;

WHEREAS, upon evaluation of JSAI's post-qualification documents and ocular inspection conducted on JSAI's site, BAC with the recommendation of its TWG dated 28 March 2023, found JSAI's bid to be responsive, having passed the technical, financial and eligibility requirements under Sec. 34 of the Updated 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184;

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the Members of the BAC, do hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED the following:

1. JSAI is the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder (LCRB) for the Procurement of Security Services Requirement of PEZA; and
2. Recommending to the Head of Procuring Entity (HoPE) the award of the contract for the Procurement of Security Services Requirement of PEZA (PEZA-HO-2023-01) in favor of JSAI at the contract price of One Hundred Fifty-Three Million Four Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Twelve Pesos and 08/100 in Philippine Currency (PhP153,478,012.08).


