

## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That this Memorandum of Agreement entered into by and between:

The OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH CENTER, a Government Owned and Controlled Corporation organized and existing by virtue of Executive Order No. 307 with principal office at North Avenue corner Agham Road, Diliman, Quezon City, herein represented by its Executive Director, MS. HELEN D. CUSTODIO, hereinafter known as the OSHC;

-And-

The PHILIPPINE ECONOMIC ZONE AUTHORITY a Government Owned and Controlled Corporation created under RA 7916, with principal office located at Almeda Building, Roxas Boulevard, Pasay City herein represented by its Director-General MS. LILIA B. DE LIMA, hereinafter known as PEZA.

### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, PEZA requires the services of a competent training authority to provide services consisting of a training program known as The Basic Occupational Safety and Health Training Course;

WHEREAS, the OSHC meets all the requirements of PEZA.

NOW THEREFORE, Premises and Conditions considered, BOTH PARTIES agree to the following:

#### I. OBLIGATION OF THE OSHC

1. OSHC agrees to provide the following:
  - a. Prepare a Training Program based on the module known as the Basic Occupational Safety and Health Training Course and implement the same in the following establishments/industrial estates under the control and supervision of the PEZA;
    - Cavite Export Processing Zone
    - Cavite and Laguna Industrial Estates (Special Ecozones)
    - Subic Special Export Processing Zone
    - Mactan Export Processing Zone
    - Bataan Economic Zone
    - Baguio Economic Zone

- b. Training Kit and all other related information and educational materials.
- c. Resource Speakers and Trainors/facilitators.
- d. Submission of Evaluation Report incorporating issues surfaced during the Workshop.

## **II. OBLIGATIONS OF PEZA**

1. PEZA agrees to facilitate information/coordination with all establishments under its legal ambit, supervision, control and affiliation.
2. PEZA agrees to promote/undertake the Information Dissemination Campaign relative to the conduct of training.

## **III. COMMON PROVISIONS**

1. BOTH PARTIES agree to cost-share project expenses in the initial training management for PEZA Industry Safety Officer. The cost of supplies/materials shall be for the account of the OSHC. PEZA agrees that the cost of meals/snacks shall be for its account.
2. BOTH PARTIES agree to monitor and evaluate the conduct and result of the training program and shall have the prerogative to exchange or access evaluation data upon request of one from the other.
3. BOTH PARTIES agree to hold free from liability one or the other for any reasonable delays or otherwise justified legal acts done in the course of official duties by any of its personnel in the duration of the program.
