SUBJECT : Chemical Control Order (CCO) for Cadmium and Cadmium Compounds

DATE : 25 October 2021

The Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) issued Administrative Order (DAO) 2021-08 entitled Chemical Control Order (CCO) for Cadmium and Cadmium Compounds, this was published in the Philippine Daily Inquirer last 22 October 2021 and will take effect fifteen (15) days from publication.

**Registration of covered establishments.** The CCO requires importers, distributors, manufacturers, industrial users, hazardous waste (HW) transporters, HW treatment storage disposal (TSD) facilities of cadmium and cadmium compounds to register online through the DENR - Environmental Management Bureau website through this link: <https://opms.emb.gov.ph/https>. The requirements for registration are provided in the EMB Online Permitting and Monitoring System (OPMS) or through DAO 2021-08.

**Regulated list.** The list of cadmium and cadmium compounds covered by the CCO are as follows:

7790-84-3	Cadmium sulfate, hydrate / sulfuric acid, cadmium salt (1:1) hydrate (3:8)

**Exemptions.** Any cadmium in finished products and materials not considered as chemical or chemical substance such as batteries, toys, electronic equipment, jewelries, ceramics and the like are outside the scope of the CCO and will not require registration with the DENR-EMB.
