PEZA previously issued the following memoranda (copies of which are also available at http://www.peza.gov.ph/issuances.htm) pertaining to the Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC) requirement for the filing with the ERC the application for issuance of Certificates of Compliance (COC) by entities which own self-generation facilities (SGFs), whether for primary or as back-up source of power:

Memorandum Order No. 2004-002 dated 09 August 2004 Memorandum Order No. 2005-014 dated 07 March 2005 Memorandum Circular No. 2005-025 dated 15 June 2005 Memorandum Circular No. 2005-029 dated 02 September 2005

Please be reminded that the ERC, under ERC Resolution No. 14, series of 2005, granted an amnesty until 31 December 2005 for entities owning SGFs with capacity below one-megawatt within which to file their COC applications.

PEZA is therefore urging all concerned entities (owners of SGFs with below one-megawatt capacity which have not yet applied for a COC) to immediately submit their COC applications directly with the ERC to avoid the penalty for non-compliance amounting to P50,000.00 (ERC Resolution No. 13, series of 2005).
