SUBJECT : Use of the PEZA Electronic Import Permit System (e-IPS) for
Importations through the International Airport in Clark

DATE : 09 December 2007

To facilitate the processing of Import Permit applications of economic zone enterprises for imported goods passing through the Diosdado Macapagal International Airport (DMIA), the PEZA Electronic Import Permit System (eIPS) is hereby expanded to cover importations of enterprises to be withdrawn from the DMIA.

The e-IPS implementation in the Clark Freeport Zone will simplify procedures and accelerate approval cycle time in the processing of applications for tax and duty-free importations of PEZA-registered ecozone export enterprises and IT/ IT-enabled enterprises.

Pursuant to its Guidelines issued on 14 July 2006, PEZA has accredited three Value-Added Solutions Providers (VASPs), to assist economic zone enterprises in the implementation of the e-IPS, namely:

- E-Konek Pilipinas Inc. (E-Konek)
- InterCommerce Network Services Inc. (INS)
- Apollo Technologies Inc. (Apollo)

Enterprises already enrolled in the eIPS may use the System for their IP applications for purchases of goods passing through the DMIA.

Enterprises not yet enrolled in the eIPS may do so specifically for this purpose, following the guidelines and procedures enumerated in **Memorandum Order No. 2006-003**.
