SUBJECT : Updates on COMELEC requirements for PNP- regulated  
chemicals / materials during the 2022 National Local  
Elections

DATE : 10 December 2021

This is in connection with the issuance of Commission on Election (COMELEC) Resolution Number 10728<sup>1</sup> dated 10 November 2021 in connection with the gun ban during the election period of the May 9, 2022 national and local elections.

All PEZA-registered enterprises who are using or importing chemicals regulated by the PNP Firearms and Explosives Office (FEO) as provided in **Annex A**<sup>ii</sup> are required to secure a Certificate of Authority to Transport (CA-TT) permit from the COMELEC Committee on the Ban on Firearms and Security Concerns (CBFSC). Some reminders:

- **Where to apply.** Unlike in past elections where CA-TT applications need to be physically submitted at the COMELEC office in Intramuros by the authorized representative, application is now online through the COMELEC website. The applicants shall accomplish the online form and submit scanned copies of signed documents to the CBFSC starting December 1, 2021 until May 25, 2022. - **Submission of physical forms via registered mail.** Applicants are also required to send to the CBFSC Secretariat, through registered mail, the original hard copies of the accomplished CA-TT Application Form, Data Privacy Notice and Consent, Documentary Requirements (i.e. duly notarized Board Resolution, original PNP Permit to Transport, PNP radio message, PNP Special Bank Receipt) together with a self-addressed prepaid return envelope.
- **Payment of fees to COMELEC.** Payment may be done directly through the main office of the COMELEC or at any Landbank branch. The CBFSC Secretariat will send an Order of Payment through email of the applicant. The cost of application at COMELEC for the CA-TT for the Permit to Purchase and Move, Special Permit to Purchase and Move, Permit to Unload is Php 1,500.
