SUBJECT : SUPPLEMENTAL GUIDELINES TO PEZA MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2024-017 DATED 22 APRIL 2024 ON THE "REVISED GUIDELINES ON THE ONLINE SUBMISSION OF ECOZONE MONTHLY PERFORMANCE REPORT (EZMPR)"

In line with PEZA Memorandum Circular No. 2024-017 dated 22 April 2024 on the "Revised Guidelines on the Online Submission of EZMPR" (**Annex A**), please be guided of the following:

### I. Additional Data Field Indicators in the EZMPR Data Entry Form:

The following data field indicators were added in the data entry form as follows:

#### A. IX. POWER AND WATER UTILIZATION DATA

1. **Water Bill Amount** - Amount due (in Pesos) for the month or current billing period
  - a. **Water Consumption** - Actual water consumption in cu. meter for the month or during the billing period
  - b. **Water Rate** - Actual water rate as seen in the water bill.
2. **Wastewater Bill Amount** - Amount due (in Pesos) for the month or current billing period
  - a. **Wastewater** - Actual wastewater discharge as seen in the water bill or contracted service provider for wastewater
  - b. **Water Rate** - Actual wastewater discharge rate in cu. meter for the month or during the billing period

#### B. X. DEVELOPER/OPERATOR ENTERPRISES

1. For Land Development (*applicable for Agro-Industrial, IT Park, KIST Park, Medical Tourism Park, Manufacturing, Retirement Ecozone, and Tourism Ecozone*)
  - a. **Average Effective Rate (Power)** - The average effective rate on electricity refers to the total cost per kilowatt-hour (kWh) that consumers pay, which includes various components such as:
    - i. Generation Charge
    - ii. Transmission Charge
    - iii. Distribution Charge
    - iv. System Loss Charge
    - v. Universal Charges
    - vi. Taxes and Other Fees



- b. **Existing/Current Power Provider in the Ecozone**
  - c. **Average Effective Rate (Water)** - The average effective rate on water refers to the total price consumers pay per cubic meter (m<sup>3</sup>) of water consumed. This rate reflects the costs associated with water supply, treatment, distribution, and regulatory fees, divided by the total water consumed.
  - d. **Existing/Current Water Provider in the Ecozone**

- a. **Gross Floor Area**

## II. EZMPR Submission Method

There are two (2) methods of submission of monthly reports by the registered business enterprises (RBEs) through the EZMPR portal, as follows:

1. **Online Data Encoding.** The RBE shall submit its report through direct encoding of data entries in the EZMPR system per type of enterprise, per zone location, and per project for CREATE projects; and



2. **Manual Uploading** - Submission through the prescribed EZMPR Data Entry Form (ERD.3.F.009 Rev.02, 15 April 2025). The accomplished data entry form shall be uploaded by the RBE through the "Retrieve Data from Excel File" and the reported data will be automatically retrieved by the system.

Although there are available options for RBEs to submit their report, we highly encouraged all RBEs to utilize the **mode 1 or the "Online Data Encoding"** submission in order to ensure the completeness and accuracy of data being submitted.

### III. Nomination Form and Explanation Letter of Developer/Operator Enterprises

All concerns from Developer/Operator Enterprises relative to EZMPR submissions and transactions shall be directly coursed through the **Ecozone Development Department (EDD)** such as:

1. Endorsement of EZMPR Nomination Form for account registration; and
2. Attestation on explanation letter for amendment and late submission requests.

### IV. Effectivity

The submission of the monthly report using the updated EZMPR data entry form (**Annex B**) shall be applicable starting with the January 2025 report effective on **15 April 2025**. Hence, the old versions of the data entry form are no longer acceptable in the EZMPR system. This circular shall apply to **all PEZA RBEs**.

**SUBJECT : REVISED GUIDELINES ON THE ONLINE SUBMISSION OF  
ECOZONE MONTHLY PERFORMANCE REPORT (EZMPR)**

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In compliance with RA No. 11534 or the Corporate Recovery and Tax Incentives for Enterprises (CREATE) Act, and in line with PEZA's continuous efforts to further improve user experience and efficient data collection and generation of economic performance indicators of PEZA Registered Business Enterprises (RBEs) inside the economic zones, the submission, validation, and monitoring of Ecozone Monthly Performance Report (EZMPR) shall be governed by these revised guidelines. This circular shall apply to all PEZA RBEs.

Please be advised of the following procedures in the online submission of monthly report through the PEZA EZMPR system:

1. All PEZA RBEs *i.e.*, Export, IT, Domestic Market, Agro-Industrial, Facilities, IT Facilities, Facilities (Recycler), Ecozone Logistics Service Enterprise (ELSE), Medical Tourism, Tourism, Utilities and Developer/Operator are required to submit and comply with the monthly submission of report every 20th day of the following month.
2. The monthly report of the RBEs with projects under the CREATE Act shall be submitted per type of enterprise, per zone location, and per registered project. While the monthly report of all RBEs with registered projects prior to the CREATE Act should consolidated in one (1) report per type of enterprise and per zone location, as applicable.

The main objective of separating the monthly report of the projects under the CREATE Act is to ensure that the performance commitments indicated in the Cost Benefit Analysis (CBA) submitted during the approval of the projects will be attained and monitored.

3. These data fields have been updated and added in the revised EZMPR data entry form (**Annex A**) and RBE Usage Manual (**Annex B**), as follows:
  - A. Actual amount of investment for the month
  - B. Employment data have been regrouped
  - C. Country of Destination
  - D. Breakdown of Local Sales:
    - a. Local Sales with deployment of personnel outside PEZA Facility
    - b. Local Sales from subcontracting services
    - c. Local Sales from drop-off transactions to local market/clients
  - E. Approved Letter of Authority on Local Sales with date and validity
  - F. Other Income:
    - a. Scrap and Obsolete materials
    - b. Others (*i.e.* Subcontracting, Leasing, etc.)
  - G. Imports data have been regrouped and broken down per value, volume, and country of origin



- H. Local purchases data broken down per value, volume, and sourcing
- I. Labor concerns data adjusted for industrial relations concerns
- J. New and specific data fields for Facilities, IT Facilities, Utilities, Developer/Operator Enterprises

5. New registered RBEs and those that have transferred to another zone location, and those with changes in the enterprise name are required to create an account in the EZMPR and provide a nomination form duly signed by the highest official of the company with endorsement from the following:

The editable nomination form (*Annex C*) can be also downloaded thru the PEZA website [www.peza.gov.ph](http://www.peza.gov.ph) under resources and downloads tab.

6. Confirmatory checkboxes will still be utilized for each data part of the EZMPR upon saving the report. The report submission will not proceed unless all required confirmatory checkboxes have been checked by the RBE. This is to ensure accuracy of submission on the part of the RBE.
7. Pursuant to PEZA MC No. 2006-012 dated 06 April 2006, the Zone Administrators (ZAs), Zone Managers (ZMs), and Acting ZMs shall be responsible for the timely compliance and accuracy of the data being submitted to the Head Office on the EZMPR system.

All ZAs, ZMs, and Acting ZMs shall ensure the completeness and accuracy of data submitted by all PEZA RBEs in the EZMPR system under their respective area of responsibility based on the Validator's Usage Manual (*Annex D*). This is to continuously provide reliable and accurate generated reports of economic indicators to top management, other government agencies, and stakeholders.

The Enterprise Services Division (ESD), as the consolidator of EZMPR, shall treat the reports as having been validated by the assigned ZAs/ZMs/Acting ZMs prior to submission to the Head Office for consolidation and generation of monthly report.

The ESD will schedule an online training for the ZAs, ZMs, Acting ZMs and economic zone staff on how to access and finalize the submitted reports by the RBEs under their area of responsibility/ies.

9. The online submission of the revised and updated EZMPR data entry form will be applicable starting the January 2024 report. The deadline of submission for the January to March 2024 reports will be on **15 May 2024**.
